REPORT OF OFFICERS:

CHIEF: TC Chief's meeting- discussion about Mark Radios. Our current radios will be obsolete in the near future. We need to start using the TAC channels. PLEASE try to make it a point at scenes to use TAC channels. TC fire training coming up at Brookfield Fire on May 15<sup>th</sup> 8-5 CE's \$25.00 need to see ASSISTANT Chief for registration ASAP. We DO NOT respond to fire call scenes in personal vehicles, you do not have the PPE necessary. EJFD did not receive state grant for tanker truck. Pursuing the possibility of a grant for 100,000 for ambulance to supplement the city and TWP.

Mississippi fire apparatus did not yield the right of way bystanders became fatalities, be respectful of load/weight of fire vehicles when responding.
