SAFETY: 9/10 New Orleans firefighters killed and one injured responding to fire call. Sept. 9<sup>th</sup> firefighter burned from flashover 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> degree, no sprinkler system rescuing a victim. Over 100 degrees, helmet melted to head, turnout gear burned. Turn-out gear is designed to certain temperature, do NOT EXCEED manufacture specifications.

We will meet at station at 630 am, Load up plywood manikins and stage them as well as equipment set-up for registration and projector/computer/screen. 8am-1025 3 in services on LZ, Disaster Mortician, Mass Casualty Triage. 1030 drill commences

Simulate first truck in contaminated, Rapid triage, Dee-con setup and Establish Incident Command. Staging 3 ambulances and 1 helicopter transport all out of park to three MERCY HEALTH facilities. Shut down de-con, debrief lunch 1230-130
