Rescue 28 had maintenance done to it about 20 issues have been fixed but still needs work on with the air conditioner and new tires. Got a quote from Fairway Ford on getting the manifold bolts repaired cost was about \$4,000 looking at splitting cost with the company we bought 28-1 from. We will be hose testing the tanker soon and will get the hose reel from Howland to help with removing the water. Working on paperwork for vehicle maintenance.

Looking at creating forms on Aladtec for duties around the station, EMS supplies and Vehicle checks for inventory. We would like to get department e-mails setup for all personal and communicate with department busy using this e-mail system only. The radio has been taken out of Hazmat 28 and installed in Medic/Squad 28 to help with radio talk. This radio does not have a repeater but Rescue 28, Tanker28 and Command 28 do have repeaters. University Hospital can not do EMS continue education on Monday so I'm looking into alternate dates.

1<sup>st</sup> LT: The roof saw is not for trees please use the chain saw with the wood chain because the chain got damaged.

2<sup>nd</sup> LT: Absent

3<sup>rd</sup> LT: Nothing everything was already covered.

4<sup>th</sup> LT: Looking at getting extra Knox box keys for all the vehicles. The fire alarm system at the school has been updated and is working great. The system will now say Elementary School 150, Pool 200, Middle School 250 and High School 350. When one building fire alarm goes off everyone will be evacuated on all buildings. Looking at getting a Knox Box for the pool and board of education office.
